## Maine State Constitution

Article IV, Part First, Section 2

Number of Representatives; biennial terms; division of the State into districts for House of Representatives. The House of Representatives shall consist of 151 members, to be elected by the qualified electors, and hold their office 2 years from the day next preceding the first Wednesday in December following the general election. The Legislature which convenes in 2013, and also the Legislature which convenes in 2021 and every 10th year thereafter, shall cause the State to be divided into districts for the choice of **one** Representative for each district.

## Maine State Constitution

Article IV, Part Second, Section 1

Number of Senators. The Senate shall consist of an odd number of Senators, not less than 31 nor more than 35, elected at the same time and for the same term as Representatives by the qualified electors of the districts into which the State shall be from time to time divided.

## Maine State Constitution


Article IV, Part First, Section 2

Each Representative District shall be formed of contiguous and compact territory and shall cross political subdivision lines the least number of times necessary to establish as nearly as practicable equally populated districts.

## Maine State Constitution

Article IV, Part First, Section 2

Whenever the population of a municipality entitles it to more than one district, all whole districts shall be drawn within municipal boundaries. Any population remainder within the municipality shall be included in a district with contiguous territory and shall be kept intact.



#### Maine Statute

21-A §1206-A

"functionally contiguous and compact territory" is One that facilitates representation by minimizing impediments to travel within the district." Impediments to travel include, but are not limited to, physical features such as mountains, rivers, oceans and discontinued roads or lack of roads.


**US Congressional Map** 





### State Senate Map












