Voters Want The Legislature To Create A Consumer-Owned Utility

The Maine State Legislature is considering replacing Central Maine Power and Emera Maine with a consumerowned utility. Supporters of this proposal argue that it would lead to cheaper rates, shorter outages and greater accountability to customers, and would accelerate our transition to clean energy. Opponents of this proposal argue that this is a big government takeover of private industry and will only lead to more wasteful spending which will ultimately land on the customers' backs. 


