

Summary:

Just as the Christian gospel was designed to succeed by acclaim, not by coercion, so must be our every effort. 

- Safe high achieving academic environment for all students.
- Public support for 85% who choose to go to public schools.
- Schools=community.
- They want Control over students and educators—what they read, what they can say, how they play, what they think
- Acting for rich white men

More Lessons

- Look for people in middle, who are staying home and intimidated.
- Not party, but public education.
- Unions, teachers, librarians, students, parents, LGBTQ+, faith groups, non-profits.
- Rally against the haters—they hate bad publicity.
- Thank and support your school board members, librarians, administrators, and teachers.

"Control" Narrative

Dunnavant <u>accused her opponent</u> of being willing to expose kids to such materials. But VanValkenburg took this head-on, <u>running ads attacking</u> that law and castigating book bans, while reassuring voters that as a <u>high school teacher</u>, he knows "the difference one book can make for a child."

VanValkenburg said he encountered many voters who perceived the right's culture wars as not just a gratuitous attack on schools, but a broader effort to expand government intrusion into kids' education. "The reason the book-banning is so visceral is that it hits on both those things," he told me.

Conservative groups hold advocacy training at Pfister

The <u>Milwaukee Teachers' Education Association</u>, the union representing <u>Milwaukee Public Schools</u> staff, handed out flyers outside the Pfister Hotel to protest an event for hosted there Tuesday by the conservative <u>Leadership Institute</u> and Moms for Liberty co-founder Bridget Ziegler.

About 12 people, most from Wisconsin, attended the event at the Pfister when it began at 9 a.m.

In an interview Aug. 10, Ziegler said she was expecting about 80 to 100 people to attend the training, though it would depend on the capacity of the room. She said she believed part of the reason the group moved from the Saint Kate hotel to the Pfister was that there was more flexibility to expand, depending on the crowd. She said the response to the event at that point had been "overwhelming."
