

Rising costs are squeezing families






Incomes aren't keeping pace






Workers produce more, but earn less since 1979



In 1975, CEO pay was 25 times higher than the average worker.

Roughly the size of a golden retriever compared to a Lego.



Today, CEO pay is 300 times higher than the average worker.

Roughly the size of a Lego compared to 2 Paul Bunyan statues stacked on top of each other.





17,000 get debt free education



- Center tax fairness


Action Items
