

#### Who can attend the State Convention as a Delegate?

 Any Democrat can run for State Delegate in order to represent their town or county at the State Convention. Just be sure that you have registered to vote as a Democrat in your town before Mar 6th.

#### How many Delegates will be elected to attend the State Convention?

 Each town gets a certain number of State Delegates and the same number of Alternates based upon the number of Biden/Harris votes cast in the last election. Note that this number is how we start. We are allowed to fill vacancies from across the county if needed so don't worry if you are not elected during this first round.

#### What if I don't sign up by Feb 20 to vote for our State Delegates?

 You may still vote by completing an online form on the Maine Democratic Party Website where your voter registration will be validated before counting your ballot. If there are any issues with the validation process, your ballot will be marked provisional and only used if your town's election results are close enough that the provisional ballots would affect the outcome.

# FAQs, continued



What if I want to run for a State Delegate position but I don't nominate myself by Feb 20?

 There is also a write-in option for State Delegate candidates. Reach out to your town committee to get the word out about writing in your name, attend the Feb 17 County meeting to ask for write-in votes, attend the Mar 6 Meet the Candidates event to ask for last minute write-in votes.

#### When will the state delegate election results be available?

- All of the results will be announced within the following week.
- How are the Alternates selected?
  - Delegate positions go to the top vote getters, and Alternate positions go to the next highest vote getters

# FAQs, continued



### Does it cost to attend the convention?

- Yes it does. It's usually in the \$50-\$100 range, and again, to ensure that everyone can participate who wants to, you may apply for a waiver for financial hardship to defray the costs to you.
- I know of others who usually attend caucus or might want to participate, but they don't have Internet access. Are they able to participate this year?
  - YES, there is a phone in option to participate. Let them know they should contact the Maine Democratic Party office at (207) 530-6391
